WHO WE ARE

Berengarra is a specialist independent secondary school dedicated to supporting students in Years 7-12 with social and emotional disability.

Our school is designed for young people who haven't found success in mainstream education and need a safe place to re-engage with learning.

We offer flexible, trauma-informed learning across two campuses:

- 📍 **Box Hill Campus:** Years 7-10 📍 **Chadstone Campus:** Years 11-12

HOW WE WORK

We remove structural and emotional barriers that prevent school participation. No uniforms. No homework. A later start. Shorter days. Our teaching teams, including a dedicated wellbeing team, prioritise relationship-building, regulation, and personal growth. The curriculum is delivered in low-stress, small-group settings with strong staff-student ratios. We aim to restore trust in education and offer students a place to belong.

WHO WE SUPPORT

Berengarra may be appropriate for students who:

- Are neurodivergent (e.g. ADHD, autism) or have trauma-related diagnoses
- Present with complex emotional or behavioural needs
- Have disengaged from school or are experiencing "school can't"
- Require a therapeutic learning environment with predictable routines, flexible supports, and a relational approach to learning
